Spring is the season when plants start to grow freely from the ground. In China, wild spring greens are traditionally thought of as a healthy food. They are still common in many dishes today.

Chinese Toon shoots 香椿芽

Toon shoots are usually the best just before *guyu*, the sixth of 24 solar terms(节气). *Guyu* means that spring is about to end. This is when the leaves are very tender(嫩的). It is often cooked with eggs to balance the sometimes strong taste of the leaves. It can also be prepared with tofu.

India aster 马兰头

The meaning of India aster is to make a horse turn its head. It is said that its tender taste could make a horse stop moving on. Perhaps because of the name, the green has become a goodbye gift, cooked when one wants to wish a friend a safe journey, according to the website The World of Chinese. The vegetable is usually boiled in water, cut and mixed with tofu and sesame oil.

Shepherd's purse 荠菜

Shepherd's purse is a green herb(草本植物) with an unusual smell. It grows early in spring and can be eaten both cooked and uncooked. It tastes a little bit bitter and sweet and can be used in dumplings and wonton or cooked in soup. In traditional Chinese medicine, it is used to improve eyesight, deal with high blood pressure and stop bleeding.

Luhao 芦蒿

Taken as a symbol of spring, *luhao* was thought highly of by a famous Chinese poet. He said: "When the land is green and *luhao* is everywhere, spring has truly arrived."

Before or during *guyu*, *luhao* is very tender and is usually cooked with meat. It tastes light and can be simply cooked with ginger, spring onions and a little chilli.

Tips for eating wild vegetables

- * Do not eat wild vegetables you don't know.
- * Do not eat polluted wild vegetables.
- * Do not eat wild vegetables which have been kept for a long time. Eat them fresh after picking them.
- * Do not take wild vegetables as a main course.

Leoh Ming Pei, one of the world's best-known architects, left over fifty designs during his long career, about half of these projects have won major awards. Pei has been awarded the highest honors from nations over the world. These amazing works stand as his gifts to the world.

The glass pyramid of Louvre Museum in Paris, France might be Pei's most famous work. Back in the 1980s, the Louvre Museum was having trouble with traffic. To solve the problem, Pei planned to dig an underground hall and place a glass pyramid on top. Many people didn't like the idea. They said it was too modern for the classical museum. However, the idea turned out to be a success. It is not only the museum's main entrance, but also a huge skylight.(天窗).

In 2006, Pei was invited to build a museum in his hometown Suzhou. He tried to include local and historical ideas in his design. He built small halls with traditional white walls and dark roofs, just like the classical Chinese gardens. Moreover, the lines and windows in the roof bring something modern to the museum.

The famous Lion Grove Garden in Suzhou used to be owned by Pei's family. Pei spent some summers there as a child. Maybe that was when Pei developed his interest in architecture. Pei spent most of his adult years in the US, first studying at universities and then working in different places. Even though he was trained in the US, the beauty of Chinese classics was well displayed in many of his designs. "I've never left China because home is a place your heart always belongs to," he once said.

Over the last century, many building trends have come and gone. But the works of Pei have not. "A lasting architecture has to have roots," Pei once told *The New York Times*. That may explain why he and his works have stood the rest of time.

Along the River During the Qingming Festival

Walking into the China Pavilion at Expo 2010 in Shanghai, people were amazed by seeing a huge digital painting. Scientist digitized(数码化) the famous painting *Along the River During the Qingming Festival* by Chinese artist Zhang Zeduan.

The original painting shows life during the Northern Song period and it includes many details of ancient Chinese customs, lifestyles and technology.

_____ Farmers work in the fields, sailors move around their boats and people eat and do business in restaurants. Parts of the background are also animated(做成动画). You can see the wind blowing through the trees and across the water. These animations perfectly combine modern technology and ancient art.

Digital technology allows today’s artists to express their ideas in ways that ancient artists would not believe possible. Techniques such as animation and 3D digital projection(投影) make art come alive.

Dunhuang Cave Paintings

Dunhuang Caves, which are protected ancient treasures in the Gobi desert in Northwest China, are filled with paintings and sculptures with lasting value. This artwork was created over a period of around 1,000 years.

The good news is for art lovers who cannot travel and for the caves. Scientists have created a 360-degree, 3D digital projection of the caves, which makes the artwork come alive. There is also a function that lets viewers zoom in and enjoy the paintings and sculptures in greater detail.

Digitizing ancient art allows us to explore the ancient practices. It also makes the whole world understand the art while protecting the original artworks for the future.

To support the employment of disabled people, *Jun Cake* in Zhengzhou has opened its ‘Silent Bakery’ where almost half the staff are hearing impaired(有缺陷的).

Nine out of the twenty staff members have trouble hearing, and *Jun Cake* has created a bakery that doesn't require customers to say anything---nor the staff to hear anything. " This might be the quietest one among all the bakeries," says *Jun*, the boss of *Jun Cake*.

The newly opened 'Silent Bakery' has a special ordering system where all food and drinks are numbered, letting customers easily write down their numbers and allowing them to place orders without having to say a word.
