This will offer you some information about our school library. You can use this guide to help your kids use our library.

Service hours:

3:00 p.m.—5:30 p.m. on school days; 8:30 a.m.—11:00 a.m. on weekends

On school days, your kids may borrow or return books during opening hours only when his teacher allows him to. At the weekend, our library is open to both you and your kids.

Borrowing:

Each student can borrow one or two books at a time. More books can be borrowed only for class reading activities and school research.

Returning:

Books borrowed from the library can be kept for 15 school days. The books must be returned before the due date, or the kid cannot borrow other books.

Damaged or Lost Books:

If a book is returned in a damaged condition, the kid will have to pay three dollars for the damage. Full price must be paid if a book is lost. We encourage students to carry their library books in plastic bags to protect them from rainy weather.

Spend time in nature.

Being in nature clears your mind and relaxes your body. Positive people spend a part of their day getting outside to enjoy the beauty of our planet. It's a great way to charge your batteries!

Practice positive thinking.

Thoughts influence your actions. So if you think negatively, there will be no bright future ahead of you. Positive people don't believe in the excuses their minds come up with. By finding the good side of any problem, they make sure they are mentally set for success.

Your surroundings have great influence on you. If you spend time with positive people, you are more likely to be happy and satisfied. On the other hand, if you are too close to those who always complain, you will have a hard time removing the negativity from your life.

Accept failure.

Positive people embrace (拥抱) failure as they realize it's the only way to learn and grow. Whenever they fail, they work hard to get to the top again instead of giving up. Even though failure brings negative emotions, they believe it is short and will go away quickly. To speed up the process, they keep thinking positively.

People say teenagers are no good. They make too much noise in shopping malls; they drive carelessly up and down America's main streets; they carry chips on their shoulders as big as the Sears Tower. And at least some of the time those things are true. But we shouldn't forget that there are hard moments in the life of a teenager too.

I watched such a moment not long ago at a woman's funeral(葬礼) which happened in a church. A teenage grandson stepped forward. With his very first deep breath, he began softly, "I want to share a few values that Nana taught me. She never failed to see light in any situation. When our family dog attacked her, what would Nana say? 'Oh, what beautiful barking that dog has!' That was Nana."

"She was a strong woman who often lived in the shadow of my grandpa, who was a successful businessman in this city. But she was the one behind the scenes who provided the strength and support for Grandpa's career," he said, with a voice now trembling(颤抖). "That was Nana's way."

Finally, in a voice breaking the air of sorrow, he looked up and said, "Nana taught me courage. She put up a fight to the end. That was how she lived her life. That was Nana's way, and I hope I can carry on in the same manner."

There are no hearts as sensitive as those of teenagers, because everything is happening to them for the first time. The trouble with teenagers is that they haven't learned to be controlled.

One of the most common questions I ask is whether, when, and how to follow up after a job interview. Following up in some way is important. Yes, you can get a job without it, but if you compete with other top candidates(候选人), following up can sometimes help you when the other candidates don't. Here's how to follow up well.

Send a thank-you note right away.

Email is fine for this and has the advantage of arriving faster, but handwritten notes are enjoyed. And if there are many interviews, send a thank-you note each time.

Find out their time line (时间安排).

Hopefully, you asked about their time line in the interview itself, but if you didn't, follow up within a week to strengthen your interest and politely ask what they expect their timeline for decision to be.

Be patient.

Commonly, job seekers are too worried about the result. You needn't look worried to express your interest in the job or hurry to ask about the timeline.

Don't be nervous if you don't hear from them at once.

The hiring process (招聘流程) often takes longer than a candidate would like. Maybe the decision makers are out of town. If you miss the time they told you to hear something, it's unnecessary to be nervous. Hiring often ends up taking longer than expected. Just politely follow up to explain you're very interested but understand that hiring will take time, and ask if they have the latest timeline(限期).
